Who are the Puhoi Community Forum?

A group of community members who care what happens in Puhoi. We work together to care for the village and its assets for current and future generations. We want you to join us!

What does the Puhoi Community Forum do?

- We administer the lease for and oversee maintenance and community led projects in the Puhoi Pioneers Memorial Park.
- We keep the community in touch with the Local Board, and advocate for the community on traffic, roading, walkways, pest control, and many more!
- We support local groups in achieving their goals and provide regular updates and reports on local events and activities around the area.

What has the Puhoi Community Forum worked on recently?

- Kilometres of fencing in the Puhoi Pioneers Memorial Park.
- Weed removal along the riverbank.
- Maintenance of existing Puhoi loop trail.
- Organised and ran workshops for other community groups, applied for and administered local board grants for local projects.
- Extended new riverbank walkway for 2km.
- New speed limits and traffic calming measures in the village.

What have Forum members achieved for the local community since its inception in 2004?

- With Russell Green's direction, creation of the Puhoi Volunteer Fire Brigade and funding and construction of a Fire Brigade Station.
- Puhoi Pioneers Memorial Park established, tracks constructed and extensive fencing to separate farm and revegetation areas, initially with Landcare Group, now with Puhoi Forum.
- 10 years of planting and weed control throughout our park. Why not take a walk along the new riverbank walkway and enjoy a picnic lunch at one of the new tables along the way?
- With Larry Mitchell's direction, funding and construction of wharves in the village center.
- Extended School Bus routes, bus arrival and departure times organized for better safety, traffic calming, 50 km speed limit in village.
- Construction of new Anzac Memorial and reutilization of Memorial Gates inside the Puhoi Pioneers Memorial Park.

What is the Forum currently working on?

- Community Orchard, Garden & Equestrian Area in the location of the old AMP stock yards in the Puhoi Pioneers Memorial Park.
- Red road carpeting and other traffic calming initiatives along Puhoi and Ahuroa Roads.
- Parking control and protection of our existing footpaths.
- Walkways and trails around the village to create a safer walking environment.
- Stage 3 of the river walkway, to create second longer loop around the outside of the Puhoi Pioneers Memorial Park.
- Continuing planting along the riverbank in the Puhoi Pioneers Memorial Park.

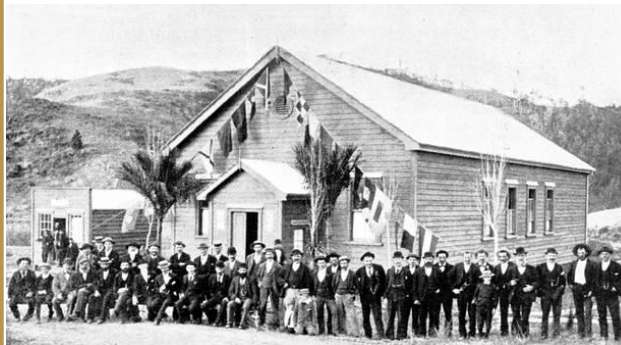
