Pūhoi Road overnight closure for deck panel installation at Arawhiti ki Pūhoi Viaduct

Hello Neighbour, July 2020

The Ara Tūhono – Pūhoi to Warkworth structures team will be installing deck panels on the Arawhiti ki Pūhoi Viaduct across Pūhoi Road early next month. Deck panels sit on top of the girders and form the foundation for the road surface on which road users will travel across the viaduct on when the new motorway opens in mid May 2022.

As a result of this important work, the Pūhoi Road intersection may at times be busier than usual and there will be various forms of traffic management in place from late July, including overnight road closures.

Overnight road closures from 02 August

For safety reasons and to minimise disruption to motorists, work to install the deck panels will be carried out at night. A small section of Pūhoi Road will be closed Sunday to Thursday for up to three weeks between 9:30pm and 4:00am. Signposted detours and stop/go traffic management will be in place. Please note the dates are weather dependent and may be postponed if necessary.

We will keep you updated if anything changes or the weather allows the road to stay open. The traffic management team may set up road cones and signage from 7:00pm, but Pūhoi Road will not be closed until 9.30pm. You will be able to travel through the area until this time.

What does this mean for you?

During the Pūhoi Road closure dates, as noted above, signposted detours will be in place. As the detours will add a considerable amount of time to your journey, we encourage you to plan your travel for outside the closure hours, where possible. A map of the detours can be found at the end of this notification.

What else is happening at Pūhoi Road?

On **Wednesday 29 July** the crane used to lift the panels into place will be delivered to our site (northern side of Pūhoi Road). Traffic management will be in place between 12:00pm and 2.30pm while this happens, with up to six trucks delivering equipment during this time.

Stop/go traffic management will also be in place intermittently on Pūhoi Road from **29 July to 20 August** between 9.00am and 3.00pm. This is to keep everyone safe during the delivery of our deck panels, with up to four to six trucks a day expected for this task.

For your safety and ours, please slow down and take extra care when turning into Pūhoi Road from SH1, follow the direction of our traffic management team and the safety measures in place.



Detours



Pūhoi Rd to SH1 SB Detour

Pūhoi Rd onto Krippner Rd Take Krippner Rd, Noakes Hill Rd and Weranui Rd to Hibiscus Coast Hwy in Waiwera, Head southwest on Pūhoi Rd toward Pūhoi Close

Sharp left onto Krippner Rd

Turn left onto Noakes Hill Rd Continue onto Upper Waiwera Rd


Turn left onto Weranui Rd

Continue to Hibiscus Coast Hwy. Drive to State

Highway 1 in Pūhoi Merge onto State Highway 1

Detour ends

The detour is expected to add approximately 20 kilometres or 26 minutes to a journey.



SH1 NB detour to Pūhoi Road

Head northwest on State Highway 1 toward Pūhoi Rd

Turn left onto Woodcocks Rd

Continue onto West Coast Rd

Turn left onto Wech Access

Wech Access turns right and becomes Burnside

Turn left onto Makarau Rd

Continue onto Tahekeroa Rd

Tahekeroa Rd turns right and becomes Krippner Rd

Turn right to stay on Krippner Rd

Turn left to stay on Krippner Rd

Follow to Pūhoi Rd

Detour ends

The detour is expected to add approximately 52 kilometres or 1 hour 17 minutes to a journey.
